Pan troglodytes (Blumenbach 1799), male, modelled according to nature, in SOMSO-PLAST®.

Age: approximately 12 years. True-to-life representation of all anatomical details of the bone structure. Skull with removable calvarium and mandible. Joints flexibly mounted, upper and lower extremities removable.

The right and left foot can be detached from the leg. Mounted upright on a green stand.
